2. The material or the item is manufactured with the following raw materials:
99% HDPE + 1% Grey Master, both Food Grade

3. We declare that the material(s) do not contain substances subject to restriction in the mentioned Regulations.

4. We declare that the material(s) do not contain substances coded as Dual Use Additives subject to restriction as in the 1333/08/CE and 1334/08/CE Regulation

5. The material(s) complies with the global migration limits in the simulant A-B-D2 in contact conditions for 10 days at 40°C considering that 6dm² are in contact with 1 Kg food. All food type listed in table 2 of Regulation 10/2011 can come in contact with mentioned material.

6. The Supplier declares to have reports about the finished packaging boxes available for the Competent Authorities.

7. This declaration is valid starting from the date of drafting and it will be substituted in the case of substantial modification in manufacturing of material(s) that can modify essential requirements for the conformity or when the quoted legislative reference(s) will be modified and/or updated in a manner that a new verification will be needed to issue a conformity declaration.
